GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 4 Credits in English
- 3 Credits in Math
- 3 Credits in Social Studies (1/2 American Civics and 1 U.S. History)
- 3 Credits in Science
- 4 Credits in Physical Education
- 1/2 Credit in Health
- 1/4 Credit in Driver's Education
- 1/2 Credit in Consumer Economics
- 1 Credit chosen from Music, Foreign Language, or Vocational Education
- 19 1/2 Credits Required
- 6 3/4 Credits Elective
- 26 Credits Total to Graduate
- The minimum student load is 7 credits
- All students whose class has not graduated must be enrolled for a full day with a normal load of six academic classes plus physical education
- Twenty-six (26) credits represent the minimum required for graduation unless a student transfers from a school requiring fewer credits. If so, the credit requirements will be adjusted accordingly
- Students may not participate in graduation activities prior the completion of all graduation requirements
